

Herbert A. Ammons Middle School Supply List

Common supplies may be shared among classes. Individual teachers may have different requirements, depending on grade level. These include, but are not limited to:

- Plenty of loose leaf paper *at all times*
- At LEAST TWO (2) blue or black pens *at all times*
- Four or five #2 pencils *at all times*

Physical Education uniforms will be on sale at the student orientation on August 19th.

It is recommended that students have home access to the **Internet** and a **working printer**. Computer, Internet, and printer access is available at Ammons in the Media Center before and after school on a scheduled basis. There is a nominal per page printing fee.

Students will need a 2" three-ring binder for the **IB Portfolio**. Teachers may specify size and requirements of additional binders for each class.

It is optional but suggested that students have two book bags, one for even days and one for odd days. **Rolling book bags** are dangerous in the crowded hallways and are **NOT ALLOWED. Please DO NOT purchase them.** Class sets of books are available in most classrooms so there is no need to carry them on a daily basis.

Humanities (Social Studies):

- College ruled notebook paper
- Duo tang folders with dividers
- #2 pencils
- Blue, black and red pens
- Colored pencils
- Highlighters
- Pocket dictionary and/or Thesaurus
- Students will be given information regarding purchase of novels by their teachers.

Math:

- A large composition book
- A duo tang folder with pockets and prongs
- Wide rule notebook paper
- 1 ream of white plain paper
- Graph paper
- #2 pencils
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Pencil box or pouch
- Ruler
- Protractor
- Erasers (the white ones work very well)
- A four-function calculator. Not expensive!!

Science:

- Composition book
- Colored pencils
- Erasable blue black and red pens
- Graph paper
- Correction tape or white out
- Personal stapler
- Small ruler
- Calculator
- Access to the internet is strongly recommended
- Graphing paper
- Highlighters
